AATE's (Adult) Member Playwright Writing Competition

Theme: "Empathy in Action"

Empathy is the ability to listen to someone and emotionally understand what other people feel, see things from their point of view, and imagine yourself in their shoes. Essentially, it is putting yourself in someone else's position without being judgmental and communicating to them that you are there for them. You are responding to them in an empathetic and understanding way.

Eligibility

- <u>Must be a current member of AATE</u> in good standing over the age of 18 years.
- Must submit all materials by <u>11:59PM (EDT) Tuesday, April 1, 2025</u>.
- Eligible original 10-minute plays must be appropriate and written for a young audience.

Submission Rules

- 1. Plays by BIPOC playwrights are highly sought and BIPOC playwrights are particularly encouraged to submit.
- 2. Adult Playwrights will be able to submit only <u>one (1) **original 10-minute play**</u> they've written (no co-writer) that is <u>specifically relevant to the theme</u> "Empathy in Action."
- 3. Completed scripts must be <u>no longer than 10 minutes when read aloud.</u> (Playwrights who submit manuscripts longer than 10 minutes will be disqualified.)
- 4. The playwright's name and contact information must not appear in the manuscript to ensure a blind reading.
- 5. The script must be able to be read by an ensemble of no more than <u>6 actors</u>.
- 6. The script must be unpublished at the time of submission to the competition and not under contract.
- 7. The script should have no more than one fully staged production and must be open to further development. Multiple prior staged readings are allowable.
- 8. All submissions must include the *Participant and Play Info Form*.
- 9. Supporting materials (reviews, publicity, etc.) should not accompany the submission.
- 10. Please create a pdf file of your play.
- 11. Manuscripts must be submitted electronically to (Alexis Truitt) <u>alexis@aate.com</u> as a pdf file email attachment.
- 12. All submissions will be acknowledged by email.
- 13. Scripts must be received electronically <u>11:59PM (EDT) Tuesday, April 1, 2025</u>. All submissions must be sent by email. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- 14. Submissions not adhering to the official guidelines will be deemed ineligible.
